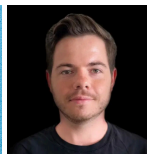

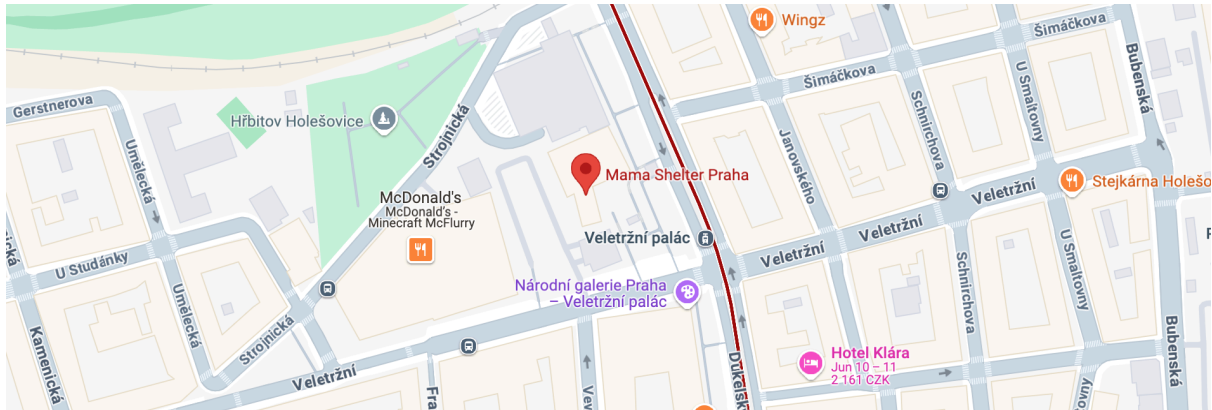

### Travel to Prague

International flights, trains, and buses connect Prague.

- [Václav Havel Airport Prague](#) (PRG) is the main airport, located about 30 minutes from the city center by taxi or public transport. **Uber** is the official taxi service.
- [Prague Train Station \(Hlavní nádraží\)](#) is the central train station, located about 5 minutes from the city center by public transport.

## 05 — Useful Information

**Currency:** Czechia uses the Czech koruna (CZK). Credit/debit cards are widely accepted, but carrying small cash for trams or small cafés is useful.

**Power Sockets:** Standard European type C and E plugs, 230V. Bring an adapter if you're traveling from outside Europe.

**Public Transport:** Tickets purchased before boarding **must** be validated once inside a tram or bus. If you are taking the metro/subway, ticket validation is at the station's **entrance**.

Tickets only need to be validated once, even if they're valid for multiple days.

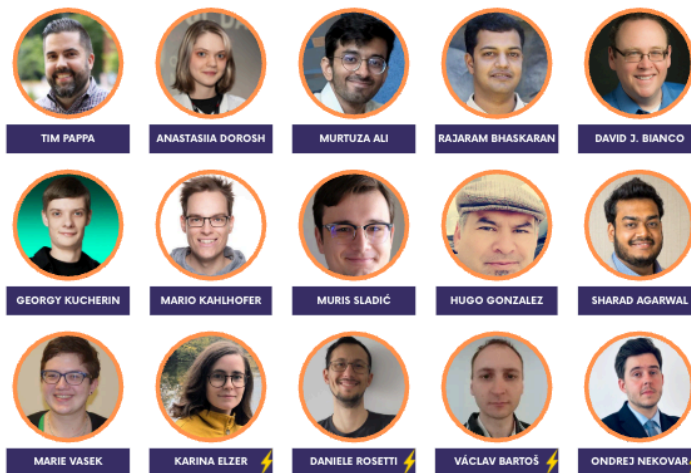

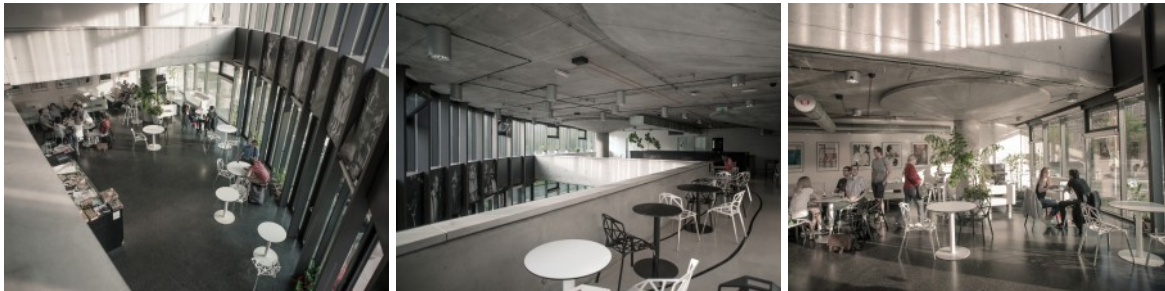
